## Hardware Tips & Advice

### General Tips

#### Door quantities

Make a note of how many doors you will be buying hardware for.

#### Door function types

Be sure to check what type of door furniture you want on each type of door – if it's for a bathroom you will need a lock plate or separate locking system.

#### Thickness of door

Our furniture suits 70mm thick doors, we can however meet the needs of those with thicker doors by providing longer fixings – please let us know

#### Measurements

Note down your backset, centres and stile measurements, please see our guide overleaf.

#### Door Handing

If you require different finishes for different rooms you will need to state which side of the door requires which finish, please see our 'Handing' table overleaf.

#### External and Environmental factors may affect your finish choice

If your brass hardware is being used on an external door, in a sunny environment (abroad), a coastal area, a swimming pool area, or even if it is being used more often, this can affect the durability of the finish. Be sure to discuss this when you're choosing your products.

**Sturdy/solid doors - If you have hollow doors you may need back to back fixings – consult your carpenter**

**Heavy duty latch or locking systems**

**Using a professional carpenter/joiner**

**Allowing time for your products to be hand made**

**Door Thickness**  
 Measure the door from the inside to the outside.



**Door Height**  
 Measure the door from the bottom sill to the top of the door.



**Stile Width**  
 Measure from the edge of the door to the edge of any molding, raised panels or glass in place on the door.



**Backset**  
 This is the distance from the edge of the door to the center of the knob or shank on the lever.



**Center to Center**  
 This measure is needed when shopping for exterior door handle sets or on interior doors where you have two pre-drilled holes. Measure from the center of the top hole (deadbolt) to the center of the bottom hole (latch).



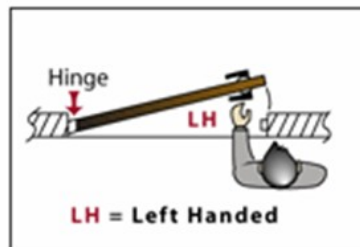

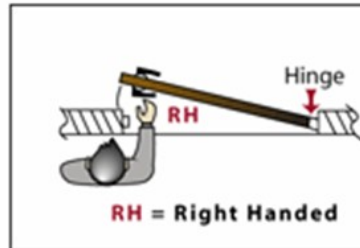
The industry standard measurements for UK locks vary on the type of lock being used;

- UK Lever Lock - 47.5mm
- UK Bathroom Lock - 47.5mm
- UK Euro Profile Cylinder Lock - 47.5mm
- UK Oval Profile Cylinder Lock - 48.5mm
- Multi Point Euro Profile Cylinder Lock - 70mm / 92mm.

**Handing**



**Left Handed**  
 If the hinges of your door are on the left when facing it from the exterior, then it is a 'Left Handed' door.



**Right Handed**  
 If the hinges of your door are on the right when facing it from the exterior, then it is a 'Right Handed' door.
