## Taking Care of your Brass

products please follow the advice provided.

### General Advice

BrassArt products, unless otherwise stated, have been coated with a good hard wearing lacquer.

Regular dusting with a soft cloth or fine camel hair brush supplemented by an occasional washing with warm soapy water will keep the article in good condition. Ensure any liquid is fully dried off to prevent water marks.

It is imperative that under no circumstances should metal polish or abrasive cleaners be used. Where the wrong method of cleaning has been applied the lacquer coating will become damaged and cause early discoloration.

### Products for External Use

Products for use in outdoor areas have been specially coated using an outdoor lacquer.

After regular dusting it is advisable to apply a thin coating of a good wax polish once a week to assist in maintaining the finish.

**NOTE:** The life of lacquer is beyond the control of the manufacturers and as such cannot be guaranteed. After prolonged exposure to atmospheric conditions the lacquer finish may break down. Should this occur any trace of lacquer may be removed by the application of a good quality paint stripper used according to the manufacturer's instructions. This will leave the item in a condition to be cleaned with a metal polish or other similar cleaners

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
